At the recent House of Bishops meeting, Michael Garner, a priest and epidemiologist from the Diocese of Ottawa, gave an excellent presentation about this uncertain fall season as it relates to the pandemic and the cold and flu season. He emphasized the continued need for physical distancing, masking, increased hand hygiene and limiting personal exposures. Michael underlined for us that COVID is most easily transmitted through talking and singing because of the transference of spittle.
